



A PROCLAMATION IN CELEBRATION OF PIERCE COUNTY TRAILS DAY

WHEREAS, the last Saturday of July each year is celebrated as Pierce County Trails Day by ForeverGreen Trails and a network of partners and community members across Pierce County; and

WHEREAS, the goal of Pierce County Trails Day is to make getting outside and being active easy and accessible while also fostering a sense of stewardship; and

WHEREAS, Metro Parks Tacoma stewards dozens of trails across parks and open spaces in our District, which community members use to be active, spend time in nature, socialize with one another, safely travel and explore the beauty of our region; and

WHEREAS, trails play an essential role for the health, safety, connectivity and economic vitality of our community; and

WHEREAS, trails connect community members from diverse economic and cultural backgrounds, ages, abilities, interests, and locations in our region; and

WHEREAS, Pierce County Trails Day will offer dozens of free recreation and stewardship activities across Pierce County, including three hosted by Metro Parks Tacoma, to celebrate these treasured pathways that connect us with nature and one another.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Park Commissioners hereby honors and recognizes July 27, 2024, as Pierce County Trails Day.
